Evana Network Welcomes New Congregations

We are very excited to welcome new congregations to the Evana Network. Churches that have been in the process of finalizing their membership in Evana over the last few months include Eicher Emmanuel Mennonite Church (Wayland, IA), Holdeman Mennonite Church (Wakarusa, IN), and Agora Christian Fellowship (Columbus, OH). Pastor Josh Wenger joined Eicher Mennonite as their Lead Pastor in early 2022 and the congregation formally voted to join Evana in October. Holdeman Mennonite is currently served by an interim minister, Pastor Steve Slagel, who will be ending his term in April. The congregation formally joined Evana on January 1, 2023.

Agora Christian Fellowship is led by Pastors Rich and Becky Bartholomew and has a long history of relationship and support with Evana Network congregations. Meeting in an urban Columbus neighborhood for over 25 years, Agora has a very active

outreach mission to the children of their neighborhood and provides a home for Agora Christian Services whose programs include a child care center; local, regional, and international voluntary service; and transport services.

Please pray for these new congregations and their leaders as we encourage one another in our joint commission to share the Gospel. Please also continue to pray for ongoing conversations with a number of churches that are discerning their future affiliation and are considering Evana as potential partner for witness and mission together.

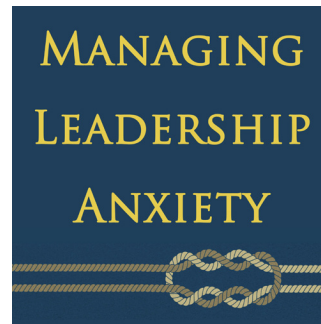
Flourish 2023 is a Wrap!

Strategic Partners join with Evana Network on Shared Mission

Since the beginning of the network, Evana has intentionally chosen to partner with mission agencies, schools, and other organizations that share a common vision and values with us. One new strategic partner in ministry approved by the Evana board in November 2022 is Malone University in Canton, Ohio (www.malone.edu), a four-year college with an explicit commitment to a Christ-centered education with a biblical call to seek Christ's Kingdom First in all things. The vision of Malone's new president, Dr. Greg Miller, is for Malone to be a place where students from Evana can deepen their faith while studying in an environment which supports our biblical commitments.

In January 2023, the Evana Board also approved a Strategic Partnership with Rosedale Bible College (www.rosedale.edu) in Irwin, Ohio, a two-year Bible college serving the Rosedale Network of Churches (formerly

CMC). RBC offers an excellent place for Evana students to deepen their faith and study in an evangelical Anabaptist environment. Earlier in the year, Rosedale International (www.rosedaleinternational.org), the mission agency of the Rosedale Network of Churches, was also approved by the Evana Board as one of our strategic partners. Of particular interest is RI's REACH program, a year of discipleship and missions training for young adults.

We are grateful for opportunities to work with strategic partners for the advancement of the Kingdom of God. What a blessing it is to be able to work together with like-minded brothers and sisters of Christ like these across denominational boundaries for the greater glory of God.
